Want to receive the Sacrament of Baptism? Baptism is a Sacrament of faith, and the Church asks for a serious and loving commitment by the parents and godparents of a child to live the life of the Sacraments. For baptism of children aged 6 and below:

At least one parent should be a practising Catholic Parent(s) to attend Infant Baptism preparation sessions at the parish. Either one godparent, or two (one male and one female), who is a confirmed Catholic over the age of 16. (From Diocesan guidelines).

Retreat for Young Adults: the Jesuits in Britain are running retreat for UK based young adults in their 20's and 30s in late July. Catechesis: Archbishop's Certificate? The Archbishop's Certificate is an online course for all in the Diocese who proclaim their faith to others: as evangelisers, catechists or adult formators. It is a course for all wishing to know their Catholic faith more deeply no matter their stage in life. You will take a systematic journey through the Church's teaching to understand your own faith in a more profound way and be able to share your faith with confidence and joy. How do I apply? This is a systematic course with study over 24 months. The Archbishop's Certificate is a 2-year course. The cost per year is £365.
