2nd Collection today for - Day for Life - 18/19th June 2022 (CBCEW)

The collection for the Day for Life is one of the mandatory collections for the Conference and is used to assist the work of promoting the Church's teaching on the dignity of human life through the support of national organisations and groups working in this field. The theme for this year's Day for Life is the *Care of the Elderly*.

Diocesan Lourdes Pilgrimage:

The Southwark Diocesan Pilgrimage to Lourdes will take place between 19th and 26th August. We are sad that, like most Lourdes pilgrimages this year, we have not been able to include pilgrims who need medical support.

Sunday Obligation: The reinstatement of the obligation to attend Mass 5th June 2022.

From the 18th March 2020 through to the 5th June 2022 the Bishops of England and Wales suspended the obligation to attend Mass in England and Wales. As of the 5th June 2022, the Solemnity of Pentecost, however, the Bishops have reinstated the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days. Parents applying for a place at a Catholic school, under faith-based criteria will need to complete a Supplementary Information Form. Evidence of practice will be measured by frequency of attendance at Mass as validated by either a priest or minister, as was the case prior to 18th March 2020. These arrangements apply to the admissions round for 2023, and subsequent rounds.

Catechesis: Archbishop's Certificate? The Archbishop's Certificate is an online course for all in the Diocese who proclaim their faith to others: as evangelisers, catechists or adult formators. It is a course for all wishing to know their Catholic faith more deeply no matter their stage in life. You will take a systematic journey through the Church's teaching to understand your own faith in a more profound way and be able to share your faith with confidence and joy. How do I apply? Email archcert@rcaos.org.uk. if you have any further questions or would like to speak to the Course Administrator before applying. The next course will start in October 2022. This is a systematic course with study over 24 months. The Archbishop's Certificate is a 2-year course. The cost per year is £365.
